

# OD Rugby Photo Orienteering – Sunday 11/08/19

**Parking:** Suggested parking is in the Newbold Road car park on the east side of the A426 between the Police Station and the Benn Hall. (Rugby CV21 2LN, SP502756, access of A426 120m N of the roundabout). This car park is free on a Sunday.

**Registration & Starts:** 09:30 to 10:30. Registration / Start are in the car park - look for an OD flag banner. The finish is marked on the map & currently planned to be in Caldecott Park by Gloria & Lil's Tool Shed Cafe.

Toilets are available nearby in Caldecott Park but they charge 20p for access (bring some change).

**Entries:** Entry on the day only (**entries must be pre-booked: see below\***) £6 per map/photo set (individual or team of 2+). Any under 16's must be part of a team and accompanied by an adult at all times

**Event Format:** One course only – a score event where you have between 2 - 3 hours to navigate around Rugby, and for each “control” match the correct photo to the location... There are 87 “controls” shown on the map with a circle and a dot marking the centre of the circle however there is nothing on the ground to mark each control position. If you stand exactly in the middle of one of the control circles and look around you should be able to match one of the photos to something you can see. Write the control number (from the map) into the rectangle (on the photo sheet) under whichever you think is the correct photo.

There is a sample “control” just near the start - if you view from the start triangle location you should be able to match photo A1.

There are also 6 extra Bonus controls that have a photo but are not marked on the map – if you spot one of these as you explore the area, draw the location of the photo accurately on the map.

If you visit all 87 controls the minimum distance is approximately 9.2km – if you manage to find the optimum route - but it is up to you how many you choose to visit, and how long you are out.

**This event is not being timed and is not a race** – you should be able to walk / jog around many of the controls in the time (depending on how long you take to decide the correct photo at each control and the order that you visit the controls). **The only timing constraint is that you need to have reported back to the finish by 12:30. Late finishers will be penalised severely...**

Please study the symbols on the map legend. **Please respect all the private land shown using Olive Green on the map and do not cross the “Forbidden to Cross” walls, fences or the OOB sections of busy road.**

**Please take care when crossing roads and car parks. They can be very busy and to assist route choice the light controlled and pedestrian crossings are marked on the map with the usual crossing point symbol.**

The map scale is 1:4000 with 2.5m contours, updated and redrawn for this event using the new ISSprOM 2019 symbols.

The map and separate photo sheet are both printed on A3 waterproof paper. Please bring a pen to copy the control numbers (from the map) onto the photo sheet.

**\*Due to the cost of printing the large maps / photo sheets could you please email an intent to attend by Sunday 04/08/19 so that I can print the required number of maps / photo sheets. There should be a limited number of extra maps available on the day but please email in advance to avoid disappointment!**
